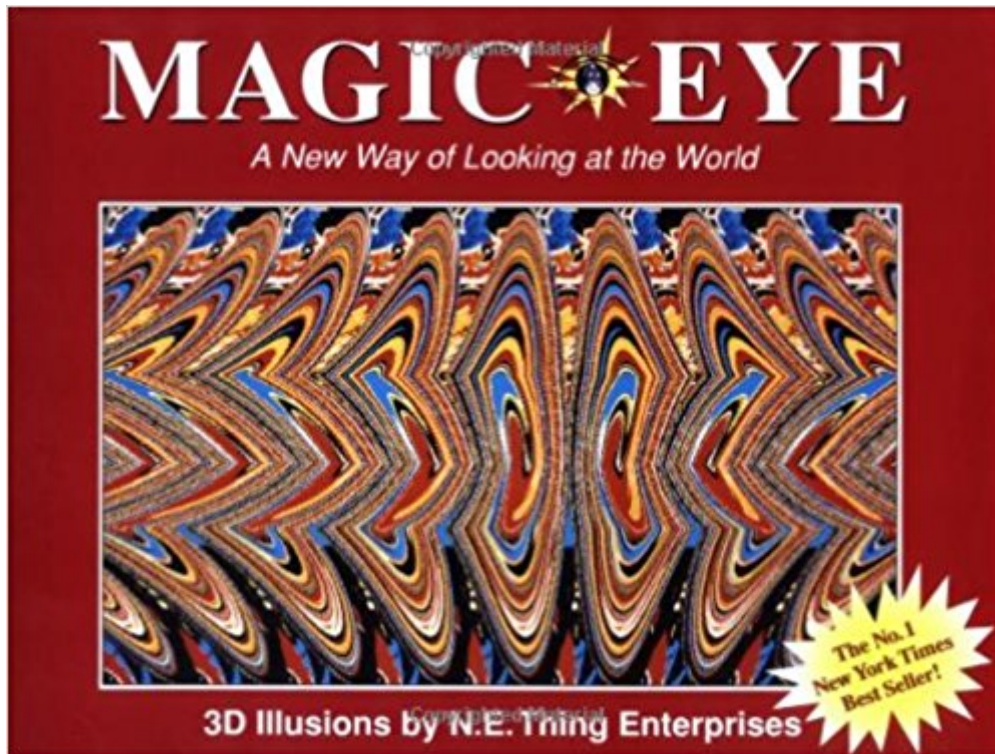

I use this book to explain "harmonics" or "overtones" in sound to my clarinet students. Harmonics are not easy to hear, just as the 3D images in this book take practice to view. An interesting comparison for musician and a fun puzzle in both cases!

I purchased this as a bit of nostalgia from my younger years. The book is just as I remember it! It does take a little time to get yourself focused correctly if you haven't done these in awhile. Great for kids as well, as long as they're okay with the practice time to get themselves to see the pictures.

This book only has about 20 pictures to view. The book is only 32 pages. I was hoping for a bigger book for the price. I got one of these in paperback that has 88 pictures. Made the mistake of buying from this publisher. Never again. Much better books out there.
